The identity and contact details of the data controller

Purpose of the processing and the lawful basis for the processing

Our main site does not collect personal information.

Our learning resources which you may access from this site or other sites may collect your name and email address for the purpose of access control and tracking site usage. They may also collect information within these resources about your activity.

The legal basis for processing is that the information is necessary for the provision of the online training, in accordance with the 2018 Data Protection Act and GDPR Article 6.1.b:

“processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract”

The information collected is not used for any other purpose, or will not be shared with any third party except in the following exceptional circumstances

- In cases where we are required by law to pass on information or if we believe action is necessary for fraud, cyber crime or to protect the website, rights, personal safety of person/s.
- If we sell our business.

We may also share aggregate statistics about visitors to our website (customers and sales) in order to describe our services to prospective partners (advertisers, sponsors) and other reputable third parties and for other lawful purposes, but these statistics will include NO personally identifiable information.

Where you access our materials via a third party provider, they may process your information personal information for other purposes and you should clarify this with them if you are concerned



Categories of personal data

The only data collected is name and email address. No special category data is collected. The training is specifically targeted at people in employment, so is unlikely to attract subscribers below the age of 16.

There are no recipients of the personal data. Payments may be handled by our third partners where you access our materials on their site

Details of transfers to third country and safeguards

Our data is held on a UK data centre, and is not transferred outside the UK

Retention period or criteria used to determine the retention period

Names and email addresses are held for the duration of the subscription.
